

## REVISED PROGRESSION RULES

*A student who fails up to a maximum of two courses shall proceed on Full Time to the next level of study*

*No student shall be excluded from any programme of study regardless of the number of courses failed. A student who has failed three or more courses shall be directed to Part Time studies.*

*A student who fails up to a maximum of two courses shall proceed on Full Time to the next level of study provided the failed course(s) is a not pre-requisite to a higher course in which case the candidate shall not be permitted to take the higher course for that year.*

*A student who has failed three courses shall be referred to part-time studies.*

*A student who fails a maximum of two repeat courses shall be permitted to proceed on Full Time Studies and re-take the failed courses alongside the Full load of the next level of study. Where a course (s) is a pre-requisite of a higher course a student shall clear the lower course before registering for the higher course.*

*A student who fails a repeat course (s) whilst on Part Time studies shall be permitted to proceed on Full Time and repeat the previously failed courses provided he/she has not failed in more than two courses. Where a course (s) is a pre-requisite of a higher course a student shall clear the lower course before registering for the higher course.*

*A student who fails a maximum of two repeat courses shall be permitted to proceed on Full Time Studies and re-take the failed courses alongside the Full load of the next level of study. Where a course (s) is a pre-requisite of a higher course a student shall clear the lower course before registering for the higher course.*

*There is no limit to the number of times a student can repeat a course.*

*A student who fails three or more courses whilst on Full Time shall be permitted to repeat the failed courses only on Part Time.  
A student who fails all his/her courses shall be permitted to repeat all the failed courses on Full Time.*

*This regulation is applicable to ALL students regardless of their year of study*

**Supplementary Examinations**

To qualify for a Supplementary Examination(s) a student must:

- a) Not have failed in more than two courses and should have obtained a Grade D+ in the failed course (s).
- b) Not have failed in more than one (1) course in an Academic Year of three (3) courses.
- c) be doing more than two (2) courses in an Academic Year
- d) Have passed in the Continuous Assessment component of the course (s) being considered for a Supplementary Examination.
- e) have obtained an average grade C+ or better in the courses passed
